A series bringing together the four greatest Classical composers. Schubert's three final utterances, by turns tragic and lyrical, dramatic and serene, are juxtaposed with works by Haydn and Mozart, showing their wide stylistic and pianistic range. The images of Mozart, the superficial note-spinner, the good-humoured witty 'Papa' Haydn, and Schubert, the writer of pretty tunes, are here starkly contradicted. The last concert features Beethoven, a colossus straddling the 18th and 19th centuries. His variations on the famous 'Eroica' theme symbolise, in the mythical figure of Prometheus, magnanimous endurance and hope against unmerited suffering and oppression.

Gusztáv Fenyő is well-known for his cycles of Beethoven, Chopin and Shostakovich. One of Scotland's leading musicians, he has performed a comprehensive solo, chamber and concerto repertoire from Bach to the present day in three continents and broadcast for the BBC, Australian Broadcasting Commission and Hungarian Radio. His previous series at St Bride's in 2011 featured an all-Liszt programme, which he also performed throughout Hungary, to mark the composer's bicentenary.
